

TREATMENT OPERATOR

The Virgin Valley Water District is accepting applications for the full-time position of a Treatment Operator. Under the direction of the Treatment Supervisor and the Treatment Operator Lead, duties include operation of 6-plus water treatment plants and related facilities for the storage and treatment of water.

At the time of employment, applicants must possess a valid driver's license and a high school diploma or GED. Certification as a Water Treatment Operator in Nevada is a plus, but not required. The new employee will be required to obtain a Nevada Grade I Water Treatment Operator Certification within one year of hire and obtain a Nevada Grade II Water Treatment Operator Certification within two years of hire. Direction and financial assistance from the District will be provided for these certifications.

The current salary range for this position is \$21.44/hr. - \$28.22/hr. The work schedule for this position is a variable 40-hour work week with rotating weekend work. Employee will be required to be on stand-by and subject to 24-hour call back for emergency situations. Some overtime and unscheduled call-in at 1 ½ pay are common. A generous benefits package is part of this position including health insurance and Nevada PERS.
