Water Distribution Technician
Public Works – Northern District

Under general supervision, is responsible for the maintenance, repair, and monitoring of water and wastewater plant operations, airports and distribution systems for the assigned area and performs related work as required.

Job Responsibilities:

- Controls and monitors mechanical devices used to treat wastewater and related sludges, both manually and using the Supervisory Control and Data Acquisition (SCADA) and computer control systems.
- Monitors, both manually and using the SCADA system, unit process variables and initiates change as determined through calculations, test procedures, and independent judgment to achieve operational goals; calculates chemical dosage for water treatment.
- Inspects and evaluates wastewater operations and adjusts plant processes accordingly.
- Records production and water flow daily; maintains well and equipment logs; keeps various records of water and sewer plant operations.
- Inspects all pumps, bar screen and related equipment, grit chambers, digesters and heaters, trickling filters, and primary and secondary basins daily and records all vital information on production totals.
- Obtains water samples for organic or chemical analysis from various locations.
- Locates distribution and collection lines as per USA dig requirements.
- Operates & maintains all components of water and sewer operations such as plumbing, electrical, and chemical.
- Ensures the accuracy and proper functioning of the treatment plant and ensures Environmental Protection Agency operating standards are met or exceeded.
- Installs, repairs, and reads water meters; cleans and lubricates pumps and other production equipment as needed.
- Engages in public contact with customers and related field personnel.
- Operates telemetry system; exercise all system generators based on “real world test” every six months or as needed.
- Repair and/or replacement of all beacons, windsocks, traffic circles, and tetrahedrons.
- Repair and/or replacement of all taxiway, runway and threshold lights.
- Weed control and clean-up of airport property.
- Ordering and maintaining stock of parts necessary to maintain all airport property and equipment.

Job Requirements:

- Graduation from a high school or G.E.D
- Valid Nevada Driver's License
- Nevada Waste Water Treatment Plant Operator License Grade 1; Distribution Operator D-2 full certificate from Nevada State Health Division; Backflow prevention Assembly Tester from American Backflow Association Possession; OSHA 10 safety certificate. **All certifications and licenses will be required within one year of hire date.**
- Any combination of training, education and experience that would provide the required knowledge and abilities and two years experience in wastewater treatment.

Pay Rate: \$22.18/hr
